**Meeting Minutes**

The January 8, 2007 meeting was called to order at 7:30 by President, Bill Allison.

Twenty members were present as James Smith discussed reporting procedures for the Commissioners, Challenge and Championship cups. All games must be reported through an on-line procedure which is accessed with a password available from [www.wasrc.org](http://www.wasrc.org). Rosters need to be complete including team numbers. Rosters may be sent in by surface mail, fax or may be scanned and emailed. Player cards must be current, have a photo and be laminated. Player cards "belong" to the referee until they are returned after the game. No player card, no play, no exception. Also no jewelry but be liberal on warm clothes. If the game needs a winner, overtimes are 15 minutes for age U15 and above and 10 minutes for under U15. No sudden death, play the full 20 or 30 minutes. Coaches have 15 minutes after the game ends to inform the referee that they intend to protest the game and why. Notification of protests go to Bill Allison and Jill Derry. CSRA game report forms are available at [www.scraref.org](http://www.scraref.org) under "forms." By Washington rules, subs are allowed on every dead ball, with the player off the field before the sub goes on. For local games teams are on one side of the field and fans on the other.

The December minutes were accepted as printed.

Fred Parrish, VP of Assessment, reported that Bill Marple passed his upgrade to grade 7.

Gene Chase, Treasurer, reported a balance of \$1,692.49.

Jill Derry, Referee Coordinator, asked officials to check assignments which are posted on Mondays so they can be finalized on Fridays. There are 24 games this Saturday and 20 next week.

Fred Parrish asked the question, "What is a penalty kick?" It took longer than expected to get to a simple and direct definition. Then after you make the call, remember to check the position of the ball, the field players, the kicker, the keeper, . . .

The meeting was adjourned at 8:45 pm.
