

USSF Recertification for 2012 Badge

(1/2/2012 update)

NEW: ONLINE RECERTIFICATION TEST!

PLEASE READ THIS WHOLE DOCUMENT BEFORE STARTING THE PROCESS.

Requirements for Recertification for Grades 8 and 9

5 hours of In-Service Training for Grade 8/ 4 hours for Grade 9

Pass the online test (75% or better)

Pay fees \$50 to WSRC (plus cost of instruction).

Submit fees and paperwork to ARA, Fred Parrish opnair@comcast.net

Deadlines for Recertification

In order to referee in 2012 you must have a 2012 badge.

The Washington state deadline is June 1, 2012 - after this date you will NOT be able to get a 2012 badge.

How to get the In-Service Training hours?

Attend a recertification clinic where you can get the in-service training hours you need.

The cost for these clinics is \$10. You can attend all or part of each clinic.

The BEST thing to do is to take the online test BEFORE the clinic and bring all paperwork with you to the clinic.

All local Recert Clinics have been completed

AND/OR

Attend local referee chapter meetings to get 1 hour at each meeting. Columbia SRA meets in Vancouver the 2nd Monday of each month. CCSRA meets in Longview the 2nd Tuesday of each month.

The Recertification Test will NOT be given at any of the clinics --- ONLY ONLINE!

Other opportunities to obtain the in-service training hours are available outside the local area: In May there is usually the Big Training Weekend in Portland.

*The BIG thing is to get those **5 HOURS** of in-service training.*

ONLINE RECERTIFICATION TEST

The test will only be given online. 75% or higher is required to pass. There is a 4 hour time limit and must be taken prior to **May 31, 2012**.

Log on to the www.wasrc.org site

Click on REFEREE

Click on EDUCATION

Click on EXAM

READ THE INSTRUCTIONS

Click on "start the exam"

What if you fail the test?

Contact the instructor you selected. You must wait 48 hours before retaking. Study - it is a hard test. Read through the Laws of the Game a few times.
